
## **CIEE Open Campus: Paris, France (Fall 2024)**

## Select courses as follows (18 credits in total):

- 1. Required French language course (3 credits)
- 2. Required five courses for a total of 15 credits
  - a. Block I: two courses, three credits each
  - b. Block II: two courses, three credits each
  - c. Block III: two courses, three credits each



## **Important Notes:**

- The articulations below indicate the IU-Bloomington equivalent credit. Please check the <u>program's site</u> for the most up-to-date course offerings, as well as the Block in which a course is offered.
  - CIEE may change the course offerings at any time prior to the start of the program. An updated list of available classes will be available in your CIEE portal at the time you pre-register for CIEE classes.
- IU students are required to take all six classes (18 credits) from the on-site Open Campus location (internship or service learning included). Enrollment in online-taught CIEE courses (taught from Paris or another CIEE Open Campus Center) must be approved by IU Education Abroad; approval will be based on academic rationale only.
- Students should inquire with <u>ksabroad@indiana.edu</u> about business credit. For Kelley majors, please contact the Kelley International Programs Office directly for businessspecific equivalencies.
- Undistributed 100-level (-OS 100) courses have not yet been evaluated by an IUB department. Courses with a DEPT—OS 100 equivalent will be applied towards overall credits to graduate. However, students may submit the course materials to that department to be evaluated for specific credit either before or after studying abroad.
- If a course is listed as OS200/300/400, the course has been evaluated by the academic department. Be in touch with the academic department to determine how course may fulfill degree requirements.
- Some courses may carry pre-requisites; be sure to check the program's site to determine eligibility.
