Select courses as follows (6 credits total):

Important Notes:

- Two sessions of the program are required, but students select which combination they prefer at the time of application.
- Not all of these courses will be offered each term. The courses listed are those that IU students have taken in the past. They do not represent ALL courses available as part of the program. You can find a potential list of courses available on the [Buenos Aires-CIEE program website](#) (CIEE does not list IU equivalencies).
- Undistributed 100-level (-OS 100) courses have not yet been evaluated by an IUB department. Courses with a DEPT–OS 100 equivalent will be applied towards overall credits to graduate. However, students may submit the course materials to that department to be evaluated for specific credit either before or after studying abroad. If a course is listed as OS200/300/400, the course has been evaluated by the academic department.
- In order for courses to be considered for **Spanish major/minor credit**, all coursework must be completed in Spanish and the focus should be predominately on Spanish language content.
