Important Notes:

- Not all of these courses will be offered each term. The courses listed are those that IU students have taken in the past. They do not represent ALL courses available as part of the program. - Undistributed 100-level (-OS 100) courses have not yet been evaluated by a department on campus. Courses with –OS 100* equivalent will be applied towards overall credits to graduate. However, students may submit the course materials to that department to be evaluated for major/minor credit either before or after studying abroad depending on departmental policies. If a course is listed as OS200/300/400, the course has been evaluated by the academic department.
- Modules typically carry 15 or 30 Kent credits (which will equate to 4 or 8 IU credits respectively). The duration of the modules may be year-long or semester-long. Students select a combination of classes to equal 60 Kent credits per term. You should consult the *Catalogue of Modules* for more specific information about the modules offered in your desired discipline.
- **Modules noted as “Autumn and Spring” are courses that are only offered for the academic year, not individual semesters.**
- Students are not able to take Economics, Mathematics, or Law courses during the fall-only option, since Kent does not provide alternative final examination options for these courses.
- Since timetabling (scheduling) can sometimes be a challenge across disciplines at Kent, students should be prepared to select a few alternatives in addition to their priority course selections.
