Important Notes:

- NOTE: Undistributed 100-level (-OS 100) courses have not yet been evaluated by a department on campus. Courses with –OS 100* equivalent will be applied towards overall credits to graduate. However, students may submit the course materials to that department to be evaluated for major/minor credit either before or after studying abroad depending on departmental policies. If a course is listed as OS200/300/400, the course has been evaluated by the academic department.
