Communication, New Media, & Journalism

Select courses as follows (15 credits in total):

1. Required pre-session intensive language course (based on placement exam): 3 credits
2. Required 1-2 core courses: 3-6 credits
3. Required 2-3 elective courses: 6-9 credits
 - Choose from CNMJ options, CIEE courses from the Liberal Arts program, or *Cursos para Extranjeros* (courses taught to international students at the Universidad de Sevilla)
4. Optional Universidad de Sevilla direct enrollment courses (Available to students with strong placement test scores, taken with Spanish students)

Important Notes:

- All courses on this program are taught in Spanish at an adjusted level for international students.
- Not all of these courses will be offered each term. The courses listed are those that IU students have taken in the past. They do not represent ALL courses available as part of the program. - Undistributed 100-level (-OS 100) courses have not yet been evaluated by an IUB department. Courses with a DEPT–OS 100 equivalent will be applied towards overall credits to graduate. However, students may submit the course materials to that department to be evaluated for specific credit either before or after studying abroad. If a course is listed as OS200/300/400, the course has been evaluated by the academic department.
