

Fee Schedule AY 2019-20 Hebrew University in Israel

The Hebrew University fee includes academic fees, the summer Ulpan, health insurance and cell phone rental. Fall and spring fees are due by the deadlines specified on the IU Bursar's invoice, which is available through *IU Bursar Pay*. The \$500 prepayment and any IUB financial aid will be listed as a credit there.

The IU Service fee underwrites the operation of the Office of Overseas Study.
