



The IU fees cover academic fees, group trips and health insurance during program dates. In late August you will be notified by the Bloomington Bursar via e-mail that your statement is available for viewing from the web through *IU Bursar Pay*. The \$500 prepayment and any applicable IUB financial aid will be reflected as credit. The total program fee is expressed as two separate charges on the Bursar's invoice. The fees listed as "OVST Fees (IU admin prog)" are the instructional fees that qualify as educational expenses. Those listed as "OVST Miscellaneous charges" include non-instructional costs of the program, such as health insurance.
