



The CIEE fees (OVST Provider instructional fee and OVST provider miscellaneous fee) includes academic fees, housing, breakfast and dinner during the week (and most weekends) for homestay students, orientation, local excursions, academic field trip, Chinese Language Clinic, peer language tutors, visa and medical insurance. The miscellaneous provider fee includes the non-instructional costs of the program, such as housing (\$2,090), visa fees (\$212) and health insurance (\$167). In late August the Bloomington bursar will send an e-mail notifying you that your statement is available for viewing and printing from the web through IU Bursar Pay. Your \$500 prepayment and any IUB scholarships or loans will be listed as credits there.

The IU Service fee underwrites the operation of the Office of Overseas Study.

CIEE Refund Policy

Students who withdraw or defer their participation and notify CIEE on or more than 14 days prior to the advertised date for their program will forfeit their \$500 prepayment. Students that withdraw or defer less than 14 days prior to the advertised arrival date will be charged 25% of the program fee.
